Larimer County commissioners to weigh in on Glade

The Larimer County commissioners are scheduled to discuss the county's formal response to the draft Environmental Impact Statement for Glade Reservoir and the Northern Integrated Supply Project, of NISP, during a work session from 1 to 3 p.m. Monday at the county courthouse offices building, 200 W. Oak St.

The commissioners will review comments on the document submitted by county staff and citizen advisory boards in preparing their comments. The deadline for sending comments on the draft EIS to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is Sept. 13.

NISP is proposed by the Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District and participating municipalities and water districts to supply water for anticipated growth. The project would include Glade Reservoir, which would be built north of Ted's Place and draw water from the Poudre River.

Public comment will not be taken during the work session, which will be streamed online at www. larimer.org/bcc/broadcast. cfm.
