Save The Poudre Coalition Urges Attendance at Public Hearings

Fort Collins, CO – Public hearings for the proposed Glade Reservoir will occur in Fort Collins and Greeley next week. The Save The Poudre Coalition urges public attendance. The public hearing schedule is:

The Coalition’s preliminary analysis of the DEIS for NISP suggests that the project’s impacts will be even worse than previously expected. The Coalition is asking for an extension of the public comment period for a full and fair 180 days to end on October 28th, 2008.

Recent scientific reviews by the City of Fort Collins are equally troubling. At its June 10th Worksession, the City staff reported to Council the following information: **"With reduced river flows, treated wastewater discharges from the City's two WRF's may, in fact, become the dominant sources of water flowing in the Poudre River from near Mulberry Street downstream to I-25."** -- page 4, June 10 Worksession Materials ([click to read](#))
