Anti-Glade group sets public meeting

The Save the Poudre Coalition is planning a public meeting to lay out its proposal for managing Northern Colorado's water supply and preserving the Poudre River without Glade Reservoir.

The meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. Wednesday in the mini theater at the Lincoln Center, 417 W. Magnolia St.

Coalition members also are expected to release their comments on the draft Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed Northern Integrated Supply Project.

The group will call on the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to develop a new draft EIS for NISP rather than a supplement to the current document, which it describes as seriously flawed.
